Giving more height by editing the image (about 10px in this case) to the left and right images that make up the modules borders will fix this problem. If you will be adding more items to the module/menu you may want to cater for this now rather than later.

The images to give more height to will be;

/images/middle_module_bl_white.png
and /images/middle_module_br_white.png

Let me know if it works for you.

The above fix will not work for you as it appears your issue is with the YOOdrawing. You can either make the content for the YOOdrawing have less height by making the images of the content smaller or playing around with the text formatting or you could give the images used for the YOOdrawing more height. Download the image source files for the YOOdrawing and work on those.
